- Show a sense of interest and compassion toward animals and have a positive and friendly attitude.
- Arrive on time, be reliable, enthusiastic, alert and eager to work.
- Provide evidence of a current negative TB test if you will be working on site and are accepted
 into the program. You are responsible for updating your TB skin test every 12 months and
 delivering this certificate to the volunteer coordinator. This is not required to apply but must
 be done before your first day volunteering.
- <u>NEVER</u> feed, hand out or throw anything to any primate. Attempts to do so are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program and sanctuary grounds.
- <u>NEVER</u> have physical contact with any primate. Attempts to do so are grounds for immediate dismissal from the program and sanctuary grounds.

Volunteers who are unable or unwilling to meet any requirements may be dismissed from the program at any time. We reserve the right to dismiss any volunteer at any time for any reason, including but not limited to the following examples: excessive cancellations, unpleasant attitude, poor work ethic, inappropriate interaction with the animals, disrespect of sanctuary staff, interns, volunteers, or animal residents, inability to work with others, inability to listen and follow instructions, or disregard for any PRC policies.
